Help needed:

Setting up a computerised booking system (need a laptop). Foot care technicians (no previous medical experience necessary), just a heart to serve and willingness to walk through doors God opens.

Initially, the clinic would run monthly on Fridays from 10-1pm, moving to fortnightly as numbers increase.

Greater Glasgow Podiatry Services have offered an eduction session for anyone interested in joining team.

There could be opportunity to have a team of foot care technicians providing care in other locations. We will follow Holy Spirit's leading.
